
The Political Divide: Alignment on Retirement Issues

Measuring Optimism, Outlook and Direction

Methodology

Results for the 2016 M.O.O.D. (Measuring Optimism, Outlook and Direction) of America poll are based on two national surveys conducted by Whitman Insight Strategies on behalf of Lincoln Financial Group from March 22 – April 4, 2016.



The M.O.O.D. of America survey was conducted among 2,267 adults 18 years of age and older across the United States, and included a sample of the General Population as well as over-samples to ensure data cuts by key demographic sub-groups that are of particular interest for this research. The final sample includes 405 African Americans, 402 Asian Americans, 402 Latino Americans, and 418 LGBT Americans.



The M.O.O.D. of Gen Z survey was conducted among 400 members of Generation Z (ages 15-19) across the United States.


Both samples were weighted to reflect the proportion of these audiences by gender, age, region, race and Hispanic/Latino ethnicity based on data from the U.S. Census Bureau. The margin of error is $\pm 1.9\%$ at the 95% confidence interval for U.S. Adults 18+, and $\pm 4.8\%$ for Generation Z.

Survey data confirms Democrats and Republicans are polarized in their feelings toward the state of the country





	Gen Pop	Democrats	Republicans
Feel a positive emotion when describing their feelings about the state of the country	43%	55%	32%
Feel the country is headed in right direction	35%	53%	18%





Both Gen Z Democrats and Republicans are both much more optimistic about the country:

- 60% of Democrats & 47% of Republicans say the country is headed in the right direction
 55% of Democrats & 52% of Republicans most likely to use a positive emotion to describe their feelings toward the country

Positive Emotions tested include Confident, Excited, Hopeful, Optimistic, Satisfied | Negative Emotions tested include Angry, Anxious, Concerned, Confused, Frustrated

Party ID Breakdown from M.O.O.D. 2016: Gen Pop: 35% Democrat | 28% Republican Gen Z: 41% Democrat | 24% Republican





Americans of both parties feel they are falling short when it comes to financing planning and preparation for the future








Responsibilities (% Managing Very Well)	Gen Pop	Democrats	Republicans

They also face similar barriers to financing planning




