
RANKING THE TOP CITIES FOR GIVING



A look at how charitable support varies by city

Nationwide, Fidelity Charitable's almost 150,000 donors make education, religion and human services the top focus of their giving. However, rankings of top cities for giving by charitable sector reveal how donor priorities differ across regions in the United States. These sector-giving lists show that Giving Account® support often has a geographic identity as well as a personal one, with the needs and interests specific to a metropolitan area frequently reflected in donor choices. Current events and emerging trends can shift these regional needs from year to year, further influencing where donors send charitable support and impacting the shape of a region's giving.

The information presented in these lists ranks Fidelity Charitable's top 30 metropolitan areas—which all have 400 or more Giving Accounts—by the percentage of local Giving Accounts that recommend grants to nonprofits across eight philanthropic sectors, including education, human services, religion, health, society benefit, art and culture, international affairs and environment and animals.¹

Education

Education is the most popular charitable sector among Fidelity Charitable donors nationwide, with 54 percent of Giving Accounts supporting charities such as schools and universities, literacy and after-school programs and libraries.
