Small business owners list regulation reduction as the top action that would directly improve their business in 2018, with respect to their business, followed by health care reform or replacing the Affordable Care Act.





86% of small business owners list tax reform as the top Congressional action that will help their business, followed by the reduction of the federal budget (71%).

Satisfaction with Congress

More than half of small business owners agree their own elected members of Congress know their opinions on important issues and 37% believe their Congressional Members act according to their constituents' input.

Trust in Government

Small business owners trust the President the most (75%) followed by local government (44%) and state government (36%). Trust in national government agencies ranks lowest at 11 percent.

Hope in Congress

87% of small business owners remain hopeful in the President and 37% remain hopeful in Congress for the year ahead. Although there are mixed feelings about small business owners' trust in government, the majority of owners would vote for the same Representative and Senator again in 2018.
