How Homeowners Choose Contractors




Nearly 50% of homeowners polled prefer to gather 3 estimates before making a decision on a home improvement project.



43% of homeowners will select a contractor based on the estimated cost...

followed by 28% who will choose based on ratings.




The majority of homeowners looking to complete a project did not have a contractor preference, but when they did, they overwhelmingly preferred to use a small, local company.






46% of homeowners depend on their contractor for brand/manufacturer recommendations.

A majority of homeowners still prefer to be contacted via phone call by contractors.



Why Homeowners Pursue Upgrade Projects





WINDOWS

Window and roofing projects are typically motivated by either (a) a desire for aesthetic change OR (b) a necessary emergency repair/replacement.

SOLAR


Solar projects are largely motivated by a desire to save on utilities.





HVAC & ROOFING

Most homeowners polled will wait to upgrade their HVAC or roofing until it's an emergency/necessity.

Promotions don't motivate most homeowners to begin a project.

Increasing home value is not a primary consideration when contemplating a project.
