49% have charged a device in their bed overnight¹




61% of Americans in the past year have left their kitchen with something cooking on the stove¹





A rate of residential structure fires per 10,000 housing units was calculated for each city using the reported number of annual residential structure fires reported in NFIRS with the total number of housing units reported in the 2010 U.S. Census. Standardized fire rates and survey scores were combined to produce a ranked, composite Home Fire Risk score for each city.
