


## Economy beats out pandemic in race for the White House


About seven in 10 investors rank the economy as top issue influencing their vote this November.

# Eight in 10 Americans with investment savings\* report their household received stimulus relief






COVID-19 reshapes investor outlook on college.



24% of investors say the pandemic has weakened their belief that attending a four-year college in person is important.




### Pandemic spurs financial planning boom


### Investor's outlook on current U.S. economic conditions
