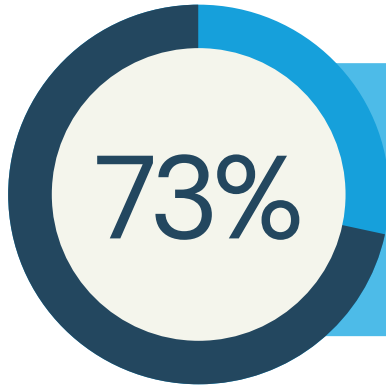

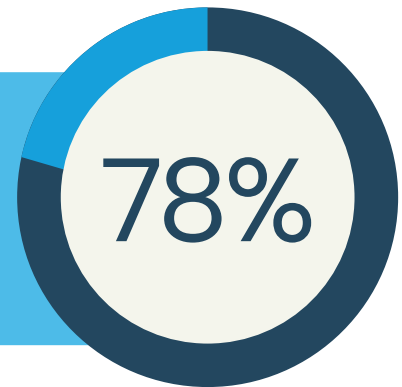
## Sick Building Syndrome and Healthy Living in North America



More than 7-in-10 (73%) of North Americans do not consider the indoor air and water in office, condominium, and hotel buildings to be safe.

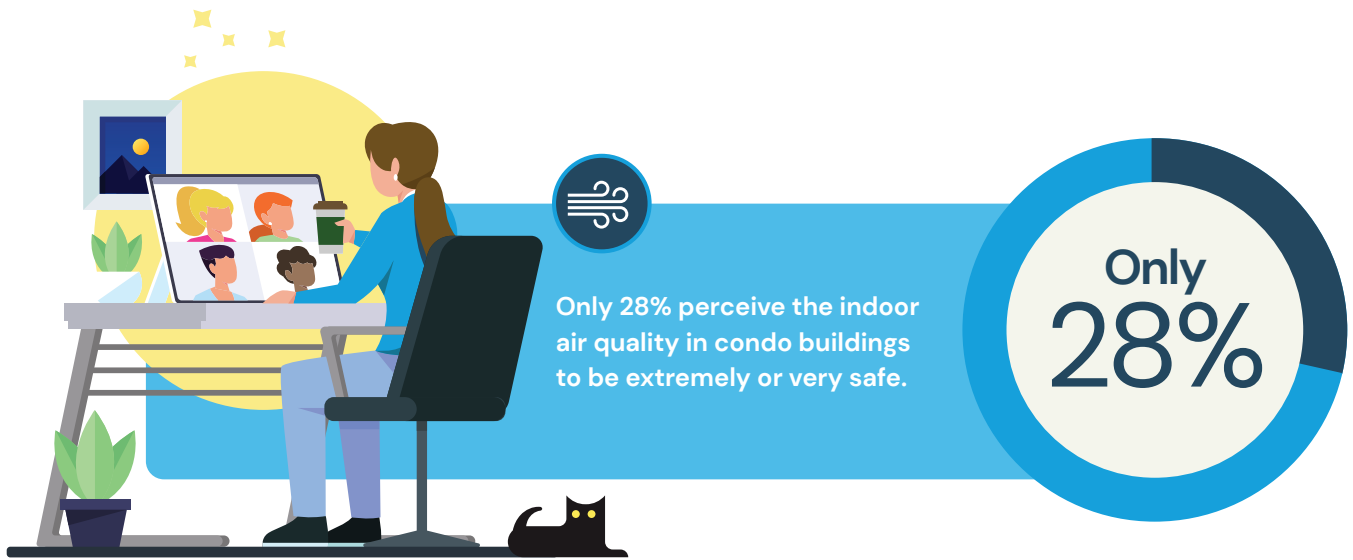


78% of North Americans agree that good air quality is a fundamental requirement in maintaining a healthy home.

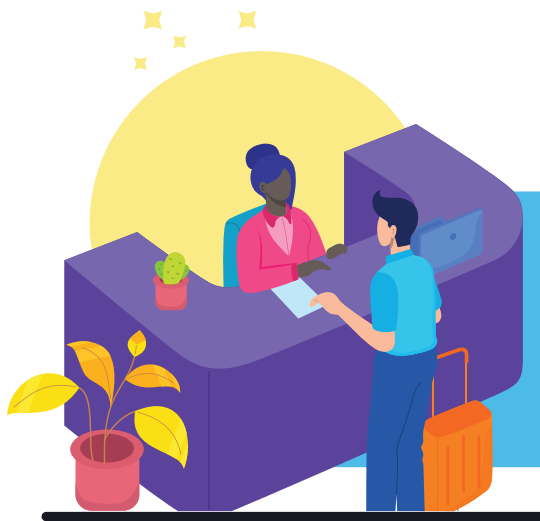


On average North Americans are open to paying roughly \$13.50 USD per month for the indoor air and water quality maintenance of the condo they are living in. Similarly, North Americans, on average, are open to paying roughly \$9.50 USD per day for the indoor air and water quality maintenance of the hotel room they are staying in.

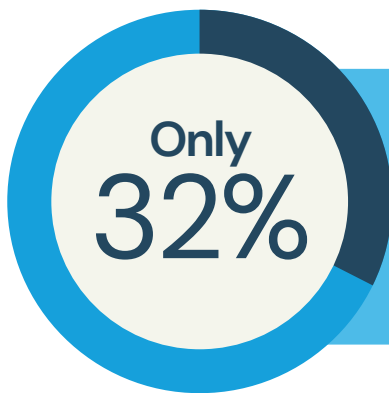
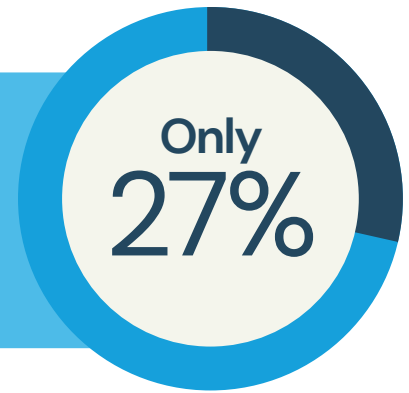








Only 27% perceive the indoor air quality in hotel buildings to be extremely or very safe.



Only 32% perceive the indoor water quality in hotel buildings to be extremely or very safe.
