## Dear Chief Justice Seitz,

We, the undersigned employees of TransPerfect Global, are writing this letter seeking your immediate recusal from any litigation related to TransPerfect in front of the Delaware Supreme Court due to your disabling conflicts of interest which prevent you from rendering a fair verdict.

When the Chancery Court came down against TransPerfect with one of the most draconian and controversial decisions in its history - the first time ever that the Chancery forced the sale of a profitable, growing business - you personally signed your name to affirm the outcome despite the fact that all 10 witnesses at trial apart from the Defendant herself testified in favor of TransPerfect and our Founder and CEO. Despite all evidence to the contrary, you chose to uphold an unprecedented ruling from the Chancery Court and force the company's auction.

As has been widely reported, this was after you disqualified yourself twice for having a disabling conflict of interest. How is it just that you disqualified yourself twice from ruling on TransPerfect when the stakes were low before turning around and ruling against the company at the most pivotal moment of its entire court battle?

Further, while it took your court system 15 years to dissolve Purdue Pharma after it was common knowledge that its product was addicting and killing its customers, it took a mere 13 months to dissolve TransPerfect, the industry leader in revenue, profits, and growth, despite our excellence day-in and day-out delivering for our customers and colleagues.

Your decisions and the unnecessary and false rhetoric that went along with them only confirm your initial decision to disqualify yourself from ruling on the TransPerfect case. It's abundantly clear that it was inappropriate for you to participate in our company's appeal to the Supreme Court, and it's still inappropriate for you to continue adjudicating any litigation related to TransPerfect.

We hereby call on you to immediately recuse yourself from ongoing litigation related to TransPerfect in front of the Supreme Court in order that justice may be served.
