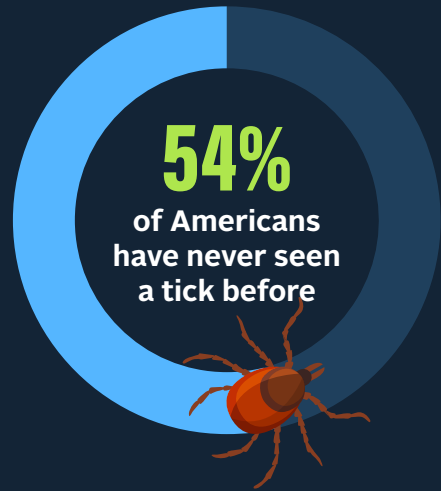




IT'S TICK SEASON! DID YOU KNOW...

TICKS ARE NOT MERELY A NUISANCE.

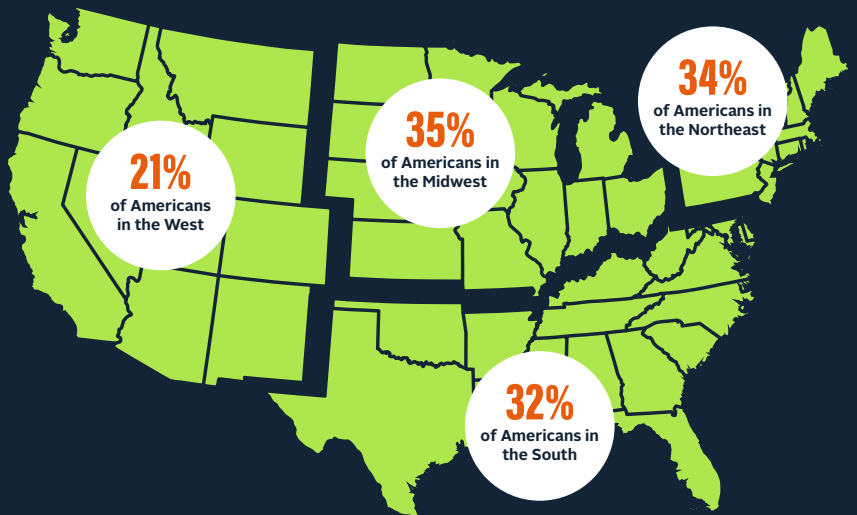
Ticks can transmit **disease-causing pathogens** and are **more common** than you might think.

20% of parents with children under 18 say their pet has had multiple encounters with ticks.

16% of parents with children under 18 have experienced a tick infestation before (*i.e., multiple ticks in their home*)

16% of parents with children under 18 know someone who has contracted Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever from a tick bite.
