Application Period

Jul 17 - Sept 12

Schools from across the nation are encouraged to submit their applications and share why they deserve to win. The chance to win prizes starts as soon as you submit your application as each school entry also enters you in the \$5K Friday's sweepstakes.

This is when you want to get students, teachers, parents and the rest of the town involved by rallying them to create content for your school to share on Instagram, X (formerly Twitter) and other social channels (i.e., Facebook, TikTok, etc.) This will help increase your high school's chances of winning the \$5K Fridays sweepstakes and becoming a finalist—with the ultimate goal of being crowned the Grand Prize winner.

During this time, we'll announce 450 \$5K Fridays sweepstakes winners, T-Mobile Tuesday branded giveaways for customers, School Spotlights, and more surprises along the way.

Top 25 Finalists Voting Period

Sept 25 – Oct 23

Be prepared to have an authorized scho	ol representative
share the following information on beha	alf of their school:

- Name of High School
- School Tax ID
- School Address and Address of Football Field (if different)
- A brief 200–750-word summary explaining why your school needs a Friday Night 5G Lights homefield upgrade and the impact that the Friday Night 5G Lights upgrade will bring to your school and community.

This portion is crucial in helping inform the selection of schools who will advance as top 25 finalists. This is your opportunity to share what Friday Night 5G Lights means to your community, why your school needs a field upgrade, and the difference it would make. We recommend crafting this prior to starting the application, so you're able to make edits and revise as needed before submitting.

- School Email Address
- School Website
- Primary & Secondary School
 Contact Information
- School's official social media handles and hyperlinks (Instagram and/or X)

Posting on Instagram or X (formerly Twitter) will be required for entry into the Friday Night 5G Lights promotion.

While not required, we also encourage you to spread the word on TikTok and Facebook to reach even more people in your community! Please share these social handles and hyperlinks in your application as well.

Game on: apply now!

The application will also ask for important files and documents, including:

- A current photo of your school's football field and stadium (JPG, PNG, or PDF image up to 50mb).
- An image file of your official school logo to be used by T-Mobile in promotion of your school's participation in the Friday Night 5G Lights promotion (Ideally in color and high resolution, and either EPS, SVG, AI, or JPGs file formats).
- A photo spotlighting an example of your "school spirit." This can include your football team taking the field, band members and cheerleaders cheering on the team, or the crowd celebrating after a great play. Please note that this photo may be shared on www.FridayNight5GLights.com as a school spotlight to showcase your Friday Night 5G Lights journey.





Application tips

While preparing to submit your application, here are a few additional tips to keep in mind:

- Applications must be submitted for individual high schools only.
- Authorized Representatives from school districts are welcome to apply; however, each application must be submitted for a single high school.
- If a district wishes to apply on behalf of multiple schools, a separate application must be submitted for each individual school.
- Please make sure your school's representative is reachable throughout the program period as they will serve as the main point of contact and receive all email communications throughout the program.
- Do: Submit the full name of the high school. Ex: "T-Mobile High School"
- Don't: Submit a partial or abbreviated school name Ex: "THS"
- Don't: Submit an application for an athletic team or booster club. Ex: "The T-Mobile 5G Football Team" or the "5G Boosters"


Next step: get social!

Highlight one of your high school's football players, coaches, cheerleaders, band members, or fans who play a key role in spreading school spirit.

Post content of your high school's student section, pep rallies, pep assemblies, parades, or pre-game chants to demonstrate the excitement around Friday Nights in your town.



Mascot spotlight

Does your high school have a mascot who is a vital community figure and the face of Friday Nights in your town? Share their story!



Turn up the volume

Search "Turn On The Lights" by Jackson Dean on Instagram and TikTok to add audio to your social post.

Then, take the mic and spread the word yourself! Share the play-by-play on your school's morning PA announcements, news updates, or gameday sportscasts.


