

Will AI make physical offices obsolete?

51% of employees believe physical offices will eventually become obsolete

as AI enables work from anywhere.

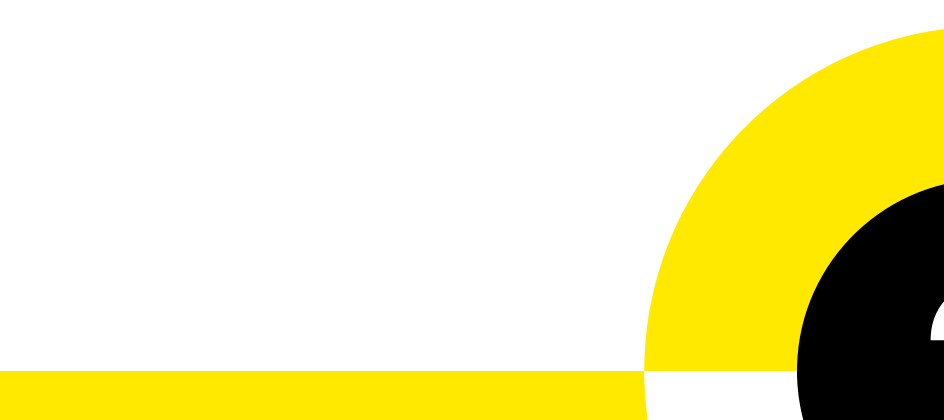
