Overview of the 1-DAY Lens Market and Menicon Group's Production Facilities

Menicon Co., Ltd. (Head office: 3-21-19 Aoi, Naka-ku, Nagoya; President & CEO: Koji Kawaura) has built a solid track record in the contact lens market through its distinctive technological innovations and marketing capabilities and will celebrate its 75th anniversary on February 8, 2026. In this milestone year, we have commenced commercial production at the Menicon Malaysia factory, one of the largest dedicated production facilities for daily disposable contact lenses within the Menicon Group.




1. Market Background

The global market is changing rapidly due to the increasing number of people with myopia, which is partly driven by the widespread use of smartphones and other digital devices. Studies predict that nearly 50% of the world's population will be myopic by 2050^{*1}.

Under these circumstances, daily disposable (1-DAY) lenses, which require no cleaning, are easy to handle, and offer high levels of hygiene by providing a fresh pair each day, have gained strong consumer support and seen demand grow sharply.
