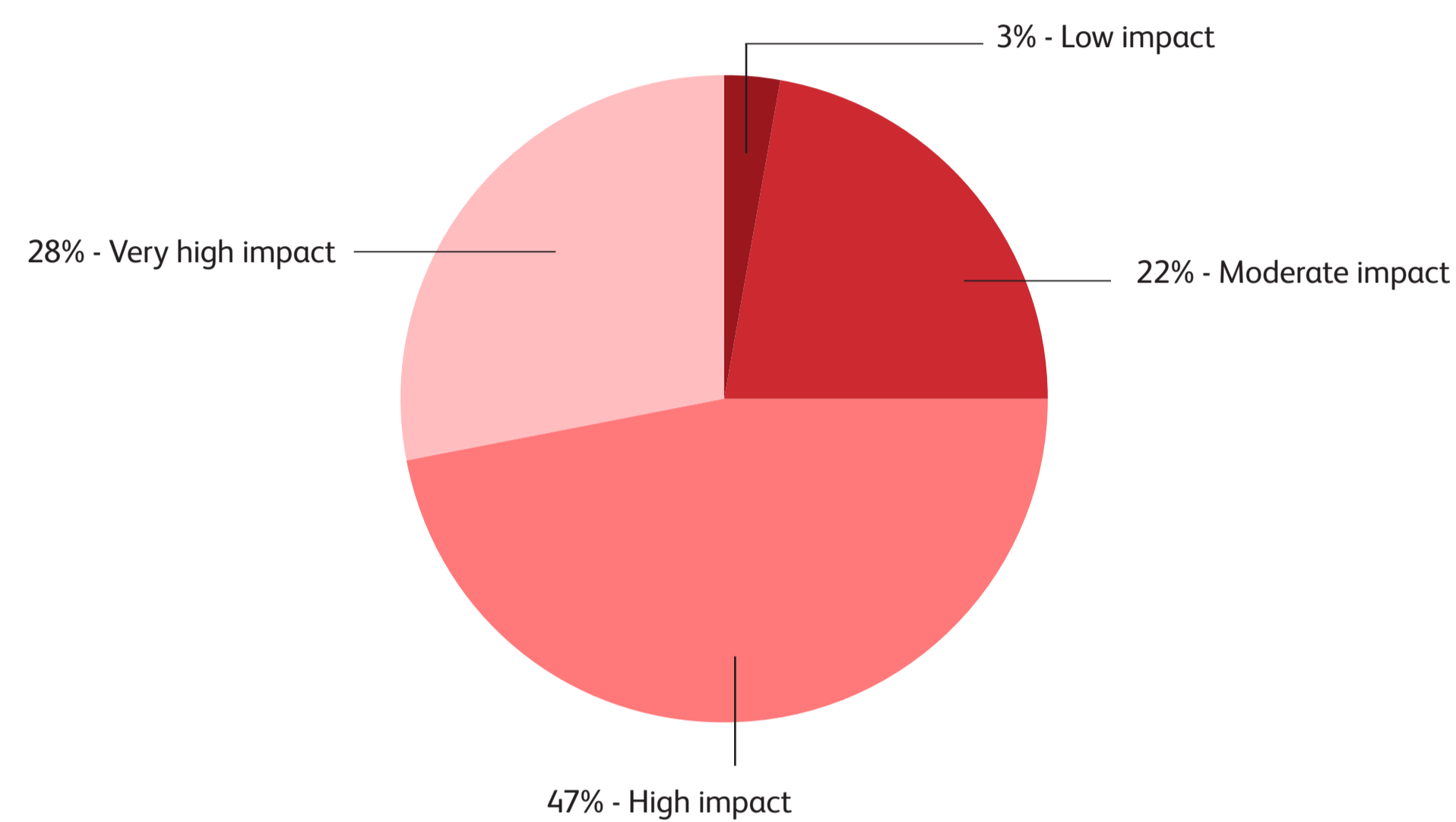


CFO in the age of AI

How finance leaders turn AI ambition into business impact?

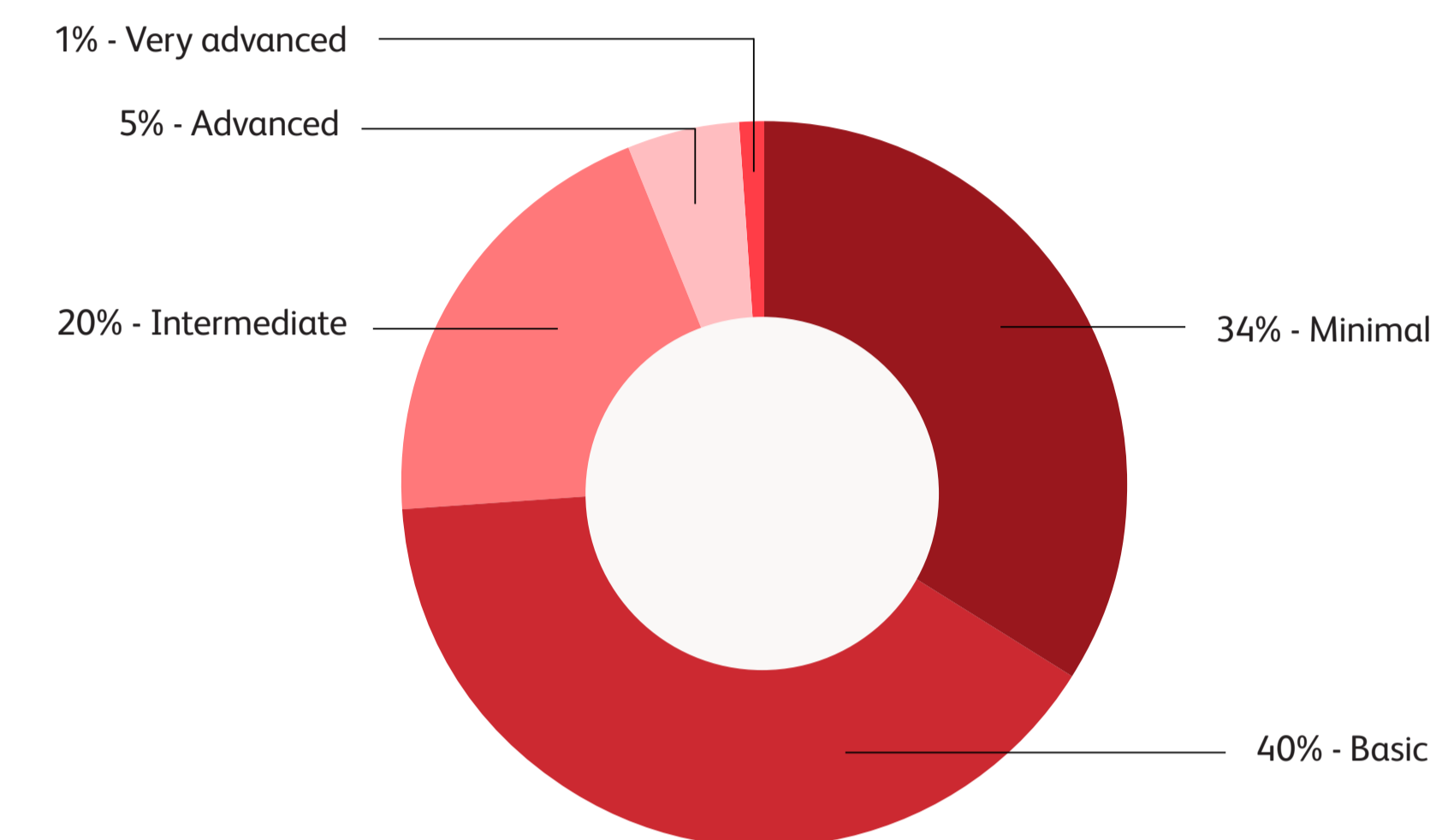
By 2030, three-quarters of CFOs expect AI to have a high or very high impact on how the finance function operates.

EXPECTED IMPACT OF AI ON THE FINANCE FUNCTION BY 2030



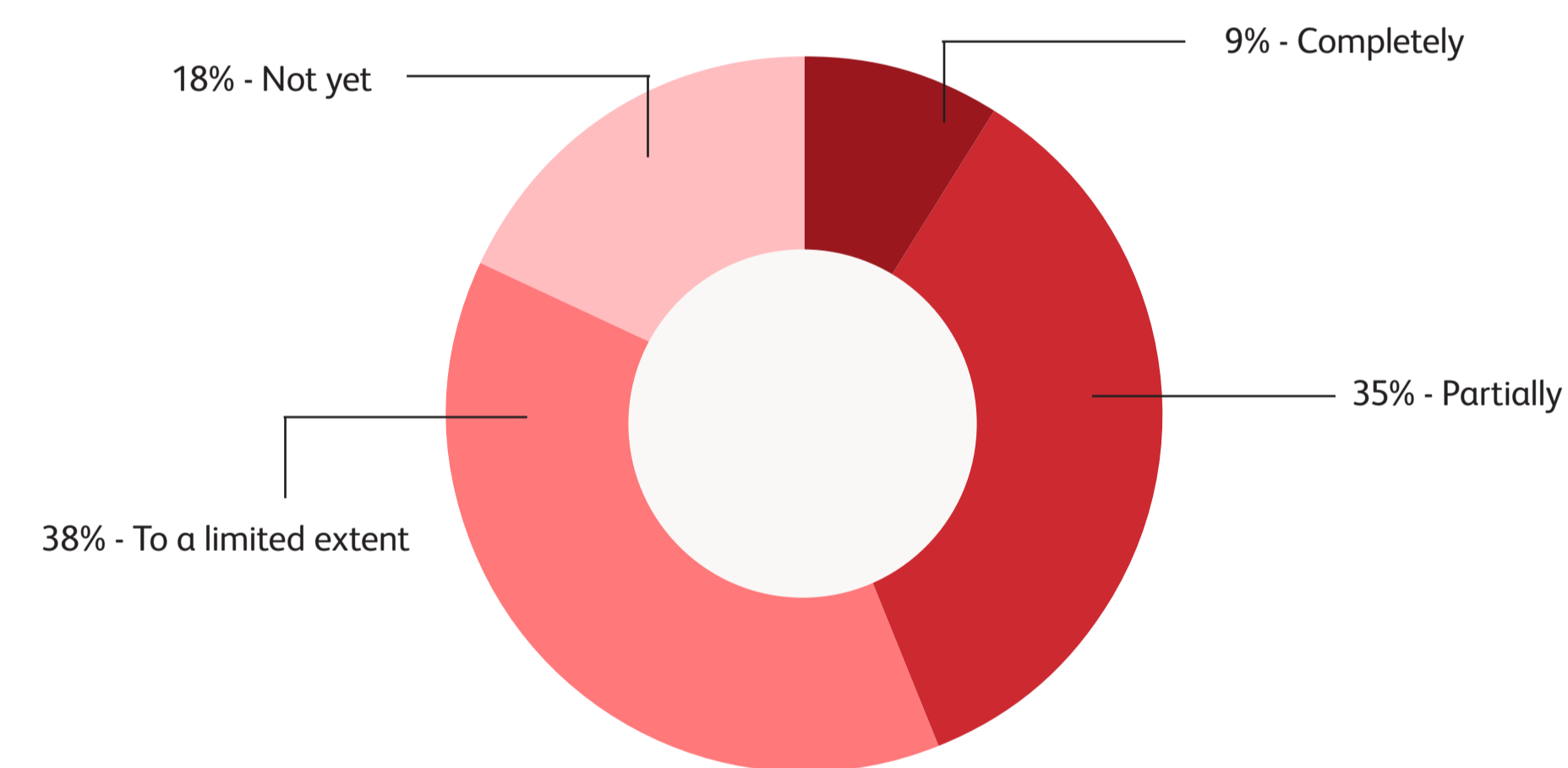
AI maturity in the finance function remains low, with nearly three-quarters of organizations still at minimal or basic adoption.

CURRENT LEVEL OF AI ADOPTION IN THE FINANCE FUNCTION



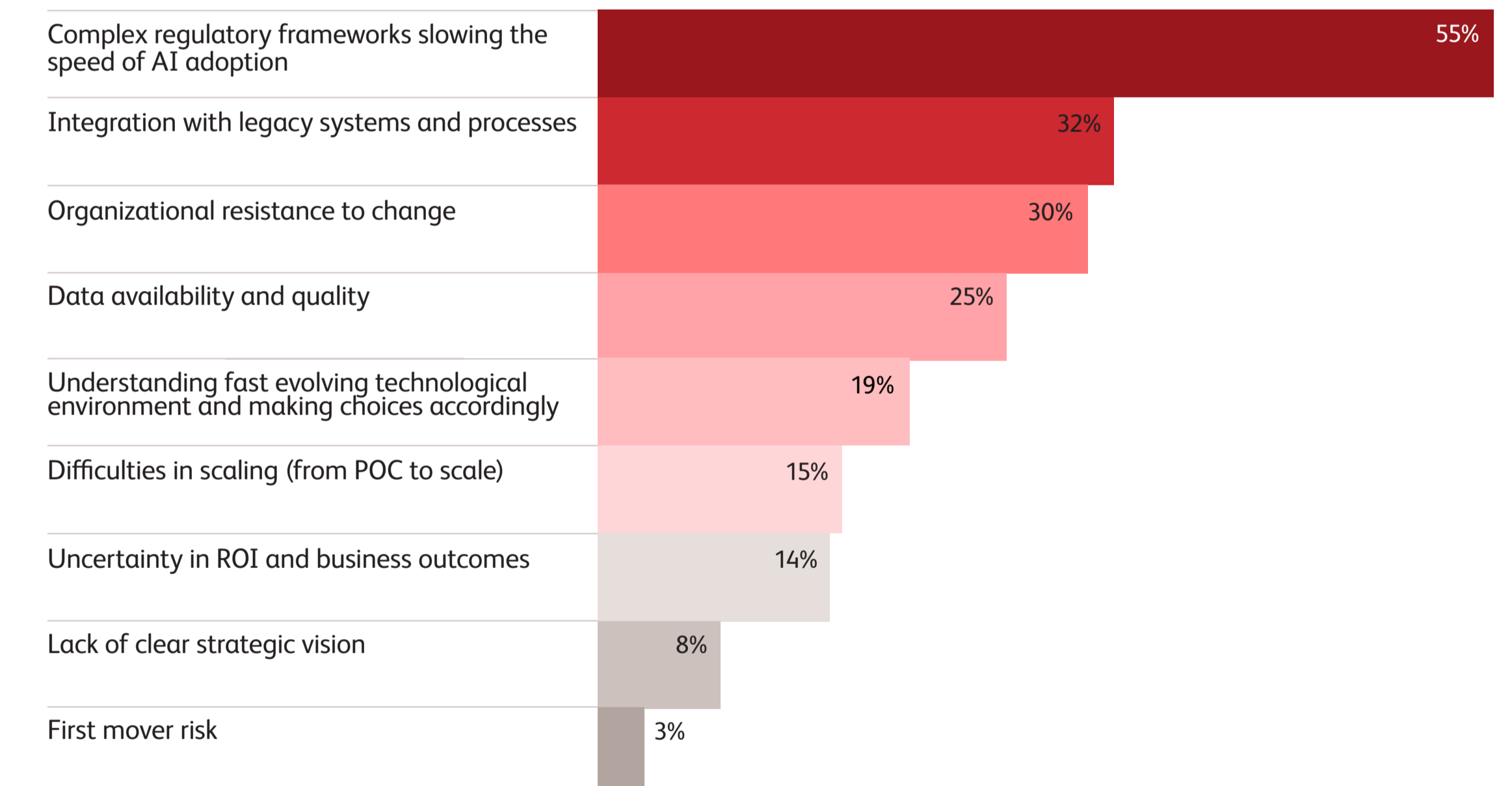
Only 9% of organizations have fully scaled AI in finance, while over half remain at limited or no scale, underscoring the gap between pilots and enterprise adoption.

TO WHAT EXTENT HAVE ORGANIZATIONS SCALED AI VS INITIAL EXPECTATIONS?



AI is not scaling in finance because structural barriers dominate, led by regulatory complexity (55%), legacy system integration (32%), and organizational resistance to change (30%).
